

Hanford Municipal Airport

Hangar and Land leases, Aircraft Parking and tie down information

The Hanford Municipal Airport has a mix of public and private hangars, shaded nested T-hangars and open tie down and transient parking for active aircraft. The City of Hanford is the Grant Assurer to the FAA and as such all airport land use must conform to FAA's "Policy on the Non-Aeronautical Use of Airport Hangars" published in the Federal Register/ Vol. 81, No. 115/ Wednesday, June 15, 2016/ Pages 38906-38911. All airport aircraft parking and automobile parking must be in accordance with the Airport rules and regulations listed in this section.

Parking an Aircraft.

Long Term Parking. The Hanford Municipal Airport currently owns and leases 3 box hangars, 9 enclosed nested T-hangars, 30 shaded nested T-hangars and a large number of open tie-down spaces. These are leased on a month-to-month basis with their availability on a first come first served basis.

Short Term Parking. A number of Transient parking spaces are available near the main gate of the airport. These spaces can accommodate single, twin engine and corporate jet aircraft. Overnight parking fees do apply.

Building a Hangar. The Airport also has a large number of privately owned hangars with long term land leases. Additional land leases are available for constructing privately owned hangars or businesses for aeronautical uses or support. See Airport Manager to available spaces and building specifications and requirements. Privately owned hangars can be sold and transferred however advanced approval is necessary for the assignment of the land lease.
