CITY OF HANFORD SEEKS COMMUNITY INPUT FOR DEVELOPMENT OF ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PLAN

Community engagement events will begin next week in downtown Hanford

HANFORD, CA – City of Hanford leaders hope the community will join an important conversation about increasing forms of “active transportation,” to improve the City’s quality of life through a series of upcoming community engagement events in downtown Hanford next week.

In partnership with Alta Planning + Design, Inc., the City is developing an Active Transportation Plan (ATP), to guide strategy and investments for improving the community’s options for walking, bicycling, accessing public transit, and using other non-automobile modes. Funding for the City of Hanford’s ATP comes from the California Department of Transportation’s (Caltrans) Sustainable Transportation Planning Grant Program.

Next Tuesday, September 19, Hanford Parks and Community Services Director Brad Albert and representatives from Alta will present Hanford City Council Members with a preview of the ATP, including the scope of work, timeline, and details on the community outreach events, which will begin on Wednesday, September 20.

“There are so many ways we can become a more active community,” Albert said. “But the reason why community member input is so valuable for this plan is that everyone brings a unique perspective because of where they live and how they get around town.”

When completed in late 2024, the final ATP will include citywide network recommendations for infrastructure improvements, while also highlighting policies and programs that can support active and sustainable mobility. In particular, the ATP will focus on improving safety, access, and quality of life for Hanford's traditionally disadvantaged communities.
